To earn the Platinum Individual designation, you need 10 recognition points from the Live or Virtual Training Programs, Testing and Certification Programs or On-line Training Programs.

Once you have achieved 10 recognition points, accreditation will be granted.

The points will also be allocated after the successful completion of an approved course provided by the various Training Alliance Partners. The number of points earned can be provided by the training partner, and can be added to the I-CAR points.

Points are valid for 5 years and expire after this period and the training recognises individuals in the collision industry for achieving a high level of technical training through both I-CAR and Industry Training Alliance partners.

## Maintaining Your Designation

Technology continues to change and the need to know about these changes never stops. Once you achieve the I-CAR® Platinum Individual™ designation, it is maintained through annual training in a number of subject areas that are relevant to your role and which offer a continuing look at the latest technology and advancements in the inter-industry.

Annually you will need to achieve 2 recognition points to maintain your designation as an I-CAR® Platinum Individual™. Individual course points expire after 5 years.
