## REFINISH TECHNICIANS



### THE ROLE

A Refinish Technician prepares and applies paint to repaired vehicles. Duties may include final sanding, masking, colour mixing and tinting, spray booth operations, and applying primers, sealers, and clear coats. He or she may need to blend colour into adjacent panels for a better colour match to the existing vehicle finish. This individual works with potentially hazardous materials, so attention to safety and personal protection is essential. Vehicles must be correctly prepared and refinished to ensure proper adhesion, colour match and overall appearance.
