The Holden Certified Collision Repair Network is just one part of our new Complete Care offering; Accident Care, which will be launched in the coming weeks.

The overall aim of Accident Care is to provide Holden Customers with some information on choosing the right insurance for them, some advice on what to do in the event of an accident and reasons why only Genuine Holden Parts should be fitted to their vehicle.

Accident Care will also provide peace of mind to Holden Customers assisting them in the process of getting back on the road. It will provide guidance on having their vehicle repaired correctly by Collision Repairers with the right skillsets using Genuine Holden Parts and GM Approved Repair Procedures. This ensures all safety systems operate as per the Holden design intent and more importantly that their vehicle will perform correctly in the event of any subsequent accident.
