Holden is pleased to announce that a process has been developed where replacement compliance labels can be supplied by Holden.




The process outlined below must be followed.

Any deviation from the process below will cause delays in the supply of the replacement label.

1) Part Number 92257206 LABEL-VEH CERT has been created and can be ordered from Holden Dealers



- 2) Additional information is required to be sent via email to vehicle.label.request@gm.com
 - a. Copy of a Personal Property Security Register (PPSR) www.ppsr.com.au and



- a. Compliance Label Request Form (CLRF) completed by either a Holden Dealer Service Manager or Insurance Claims Manager (if the vehicle is involved in a collision)
 - i. Please see attached CLRF template.
- 3) The original compliance label is to be returned to Holden **BEFORE** the replacement label will be supplied.
