I-CAR ANNOUNCES NEW COURSE PRICING STRUCTURE

I-CAR Australia CEO Mark Czvitkovits announced today that I-CAR will be restructuring course pricing to reward members and those businesses committed to training.

“As a result of increased membership and the support of many organisations towards training, it was felt that these organisations be acknowledged. I-CAR will continue to deliver cost effective and relevant training solutions to the collision repair industry and as a result of ongoing changes, the timing was right to reward the advocates of training in the collision repair inter-industry” said Mr Czvitkovits.

“For the first time in Australia, I-CAR will provide a pricing structure for its members across all forms of I-CAR training – live, virtual and certification – as well as more flexible training solutions. For large organisations the new pricing structure will provide significant savings based on the amount of training undertaken in any one year” added Mr Czvitkovits.

As part of the course pricing evaluation process, pricing for non-members will increase slightly for long courses and reduce for short courses.

This will be the second price adjustment in 10 years of operation in Australia and will take effect on 1st July 2016.
