

REMOVING AND INSTALLING EXTERIOR TRIM, PINSTRIPE, AND DECALS

TRM03

From understanding installation processes, to making repair versus replace decisions, there are many considerations around removing and installing exterior trim, accessories, pinstripes and decals. This course provides a basis for making informed decisions in a collision repair facility, which can lead to improved cycle time and customer satisfaction scores.

Course Content

Module 1— Trim and Mouldings

The course begins with an explanation of exterior trim and considerations around application. Emblem and emblem adhesive removal as well as replacement methods are explained in this module. Additionally, attachment and removal methods for weather stripping are discussed.

Module 2— Front and Rear Trim

The second module of the course includes information on underhood, grille, trunk, and liftgate trim. Attachment methods are also explained in this module.

Module 3— Exterior/ Accessories

As the student continues through the course, he or she will be introduced to various interior and exterior accessories. The student will learn to identify OEM versus aftermarket parts and how to remove and replace interior and exterior parts.

Module 4— Pinstripes/ Decals

Learning objectives for this module include tools for applying painted pinstripes, as well as application and removal techniques for decals.
