I-CAR® Platinum Individual™ was created to recognise individuals in the collision industry for achieving a high level of technical training through I-CAR Australia and its **Industry Training Alliance partners**. To maintain this designation, individuals must re-qualify annually. I-CAR Australia is not responsible for the conduct or the quality of repairs of any business or their employees that may have earned or displays the I-CAR® Platinum Individual™ logo.

10 recognition points are required from the following programs in order to achieve Platinum Individual designation:

- Live training
- Virtual training
- Online training
- Testing and certification

Once an individual has achieved 10 recognition points, accreditation is granted.

Points can also be allocated after the successful completion of an approved course delivered by Industry Training Alliance partners.

Once an individual achieves Platinum Individual designation, accreditation is maintained by the individual successfully completing role-relevant annual training. A minimum of 2 recognition points per year is required to maintain this designation.
